Funder views

Cautious Optimism: Many UK funders see the potential of AI to improve efficiency, especially in grant assessment and reporting, but are proceeding carefully due to concerns about bias, transparency, and impact on trust.

Interest in Experimentation: Some progressive funders (e.g., the National Lottery Community Fund, Paul Hamlyn Foundation) are piloting AI tools for internal processes or funding research into AI ethics and applications for civil society.

Equity and Inclusion Concerns: There is a shared anxiety about how AI might exacerbate existing inequalities in funding access, particularly for smaller or grassroots organisations without tech capacity.

Lack of Policy Clarity: Few funders have developed formal strategies or ethical guidelines for AI, leading to ad hoc use and a desire for more sector-wide frameworks and shared learning.

National Lottery Example

Al as a force for good: The Fund promotes Al as a powerful tool that—if used ethically and inclusively—can benefit people and communities.

Guidance and encouragement for applicants: They published guidance allowing applicants to use tools like ChatGPT, Gemini, Copilot, and Claude to draft funding applications—stating applications won't be penalised for AI use

10 ethical AI principles: The Fund has defined ten core principles—such as keeping humans in the loop, ensuring transparency, inclusivity, privacy by design, accountability, environmental awareness, and continuous monitoring

Pilot projects supporting vulnerable communities: Their support includes Al-powered initiatives like "Cecil from WECIL," a chatbot built for and by disabled people to improve accessibility
